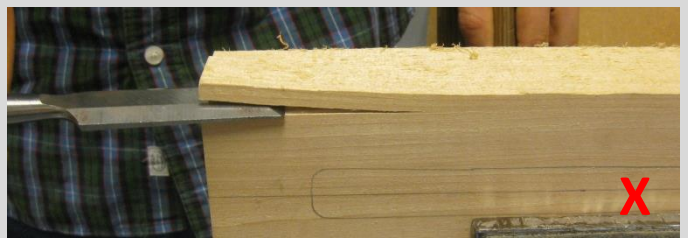


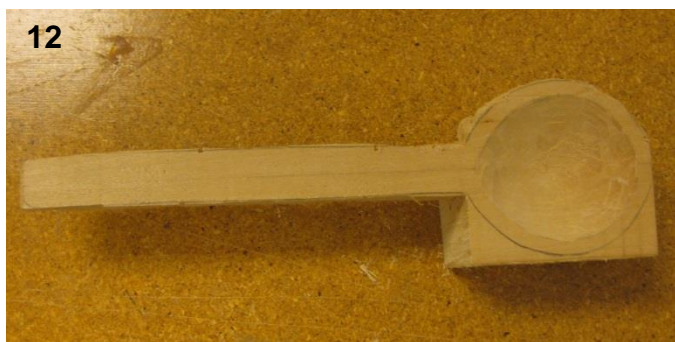
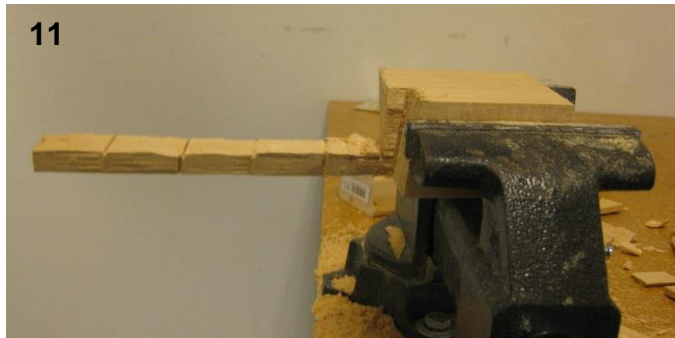
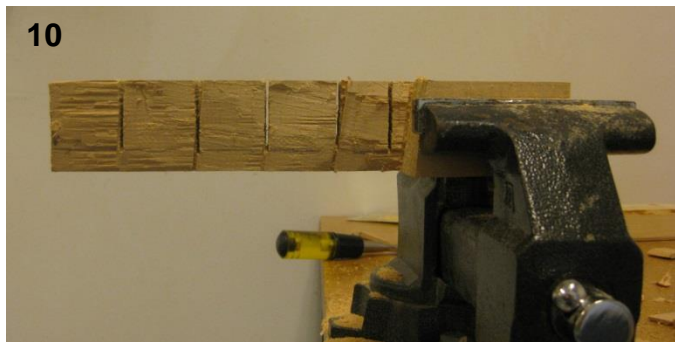
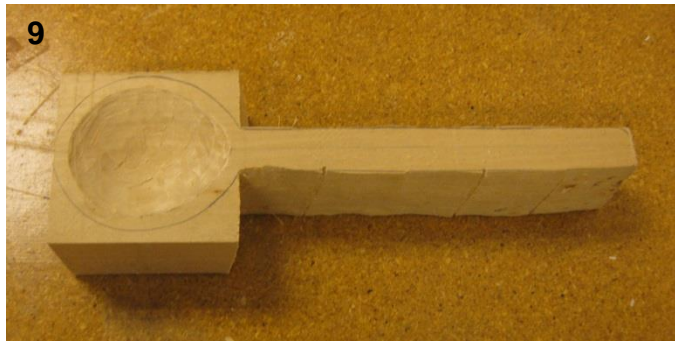


The chisel's blade is directional.

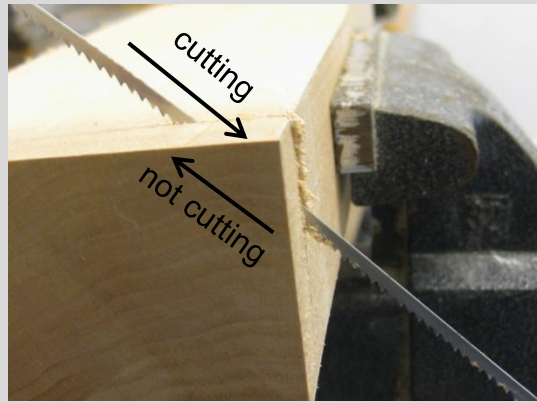


Create "end points" perpendicular to the chiseling direction using a wood or coping saw to prevent crack propagations.

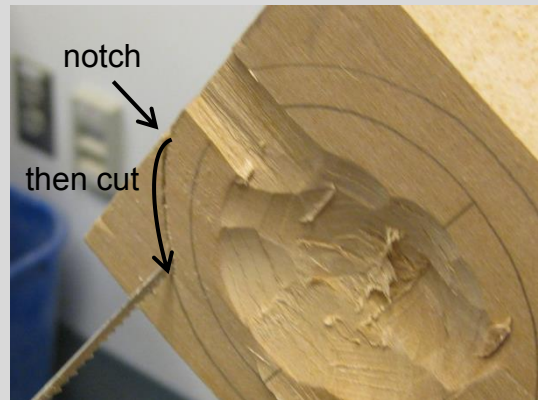




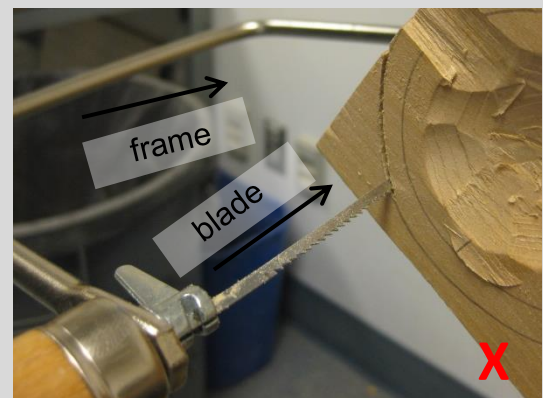
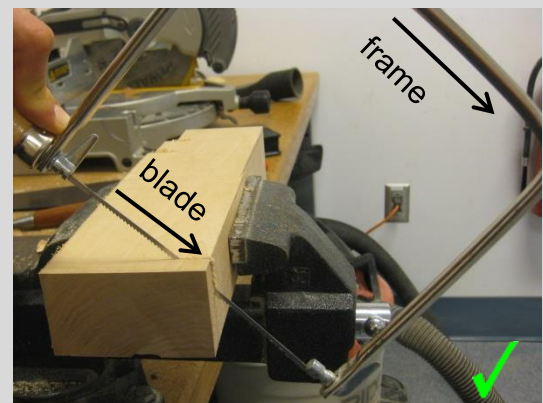
Apply force in the cutting direction only.

Keep the blade parallel with the saw's frame. Twisting the blade will cause it to break.

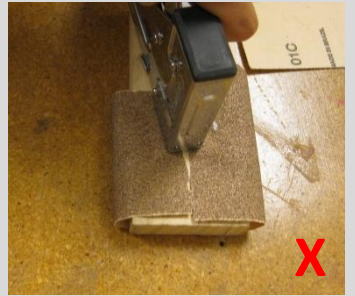




Use an edge to tear sand paper.
